One of the most popular and sought after callers in the world, Tony was ntroduced to square dancing in 1972 through a

teenage square dance program sponsored by the local Parks and Recreation Department. In 1974 Tony attended Promenade Hall Callers College in Indiana. Success quickly followed. In 1980 Tony made the decision to go full-time with his calling. Tony travels almost 300 days annually doing festivals and dances all over the world. Tony, along with his partner Jerry Story, are co-owners of one of the most popular square dance record labels - Royal Records. Tony is an Accredited Caller Coach and an accredited member of CALLERLAB.





TJ began square dancing in 1975 with a teen group in Boise, Idaho, began round dancing in 1980. Bruce caught the square dance

bug in 1995 after attending a square dance on a blind date and sitting on the sidelines watching everyone else dance with his date That fall he joined beginning classes at 3 different square dance clubs, determined not to sit on the sidelines ever again. They were introduced by mutual friends in 1996 and what started out as "just dance partners" turned into much more and they were married in April, 1999. Adam has been around square dancing his whole life. At the age of 3 Adam's club aller. Wayne Thompson, gave him his first

singing call. At age 6 Adam called his song for the first time at a Montana State Square Dance Festival. In 2003, at age 12, he started calling and teaching for his first club in Plains, MT, which became The Montana Mayericks in 2004. Adam has called dances in Montana, Idaho, Washington, Oregon, California, and Texas within the United States, Outside the United States he has called in Canada and Scotland. He has been featured caller for many weekend festivals, state festivals, and square dance cruises. In 2013, Adam became the newest member of Rhythm Records. Adam & his wife, Samantha, along with son (Avi) and daughter (Adorabella) reside in Spokane, WA. Adam is a member of CALLERLAB.
